Requirements to enter the technical part of the program

- A minimum GPA of 2.75 required and a minimum grade of C in each pre-requisite (Except Intro to Nursing, A&P I & II, & Intro to Nursing need a B- minimum). Effective Fall 2020, the minimum requirement will be increased to 2.75.
