- Students have the opportunity to develop skills with one of our industry partners during a **192-hour carpentry internship**.
- Opportunity to participate in competitions such as **Skills-USA** and **Team Works**.

Program Description

The Kirkwood Carpentry program prepares students to enter the skilled building trades. Students are given a hands-on intensive introduction to the skills used by carpenters. The classroom experience combines lecture and lab activities that cover all aspects of a carpenter's job. Students may choose to pursue an Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree in the Construction Management program upon completion of the Carpentry program.
